- 2. They are corrupt and they also a heinous work have wrought: Among them all there is not one, of good that worketh ought.
- 3. The Lord looked down on sons of men from heaven all abroad:
  To see if any were that would be wise, and seek for God.
- 4. They are all gone out of the way, they are corrupted all:
  There is no one doth any good, there is not one at all.
- 5. Do not all wicked workers know that they do feed upon My people as they feed on bread? the Lord they call not on.
- 6. Even there they were afraid and stood with trembling all dismayed: Whereas there was no cause at all why they should be afraid.
- 7. For God his bones that thee besieged hath scattered all abroad: Thou hast confounded them, for they rejected are of God.
- 8. O Lord give thou thy people health, and thou O Lord fulfill Thy promise made to Israel, from out of Sion hill.
- 9. When God his people shall restore, that earst was captive led: Then Jacob shall therein rejoice, and Israel shall be glad.
