- 1. the measure is repeated by each performer ad libitum (or ad nauseum, depending on one's perspective)
- 2. performer 1 starts. After many repeats, performer 2 is added, then after many repeats of the combined parts of performers 1 and 2, performer 3 is added, etc. Once started, each part is repeated until all 12 performers are playing their respective parts together.
- 3. once all 12 players are performing their parts together many times, the performers exit in reverse order (eg, 12 exits, then 11, ...), leaving performer 1 to finish the work by repeating his/her part as many times as desired
- 4. tempo is between J = 60 and J = 120
- 5. the dynamic level is quiet
- 6. all performers could be identical (eg, piano), similar (eg, strings) or very heterogeneous; octave transposition is permitted, when necessary
