That piece - Capriccio - is one of Ludolf Nielsens most unconventional works. With an ostinato character in the piano, Ludolf Nielsen developed a musical river (Bækken) with a few drops in the woodwind.. That piece is also known as piano-solo work which was finished on the 14th January 1922 in Hellerup. It was first titled "Skovstykken" - Forestpiece -, but L.N. canceled it and so it's today listened as "Klaver-Etude" JC A2 in his worklist compiled by Jens Cornelius. This version for Flute, Oboe and Cello is mentioned as JC A6.
