**W**elcher gestalt das Resonet in laudibus, &c. Num. 30. in dieser Evlogodia vnd das 91. im V. Theil meiner deutschen Musarum Sioniarum könne angeordnet werden.

1. Vnd erstlich/ so kan man es mit sieben Stimmen allein/ ohne oder mit Instrumentisten in die Orgel/ Positiueff oder Regal musiciren lassen/ Welches ein jeder Cantor nach seinem besten gefallen vnd verstande wol wird anzustellen wissen.

2.
