# 'Valediction' for solo trumpet (in C)

(1) Very fast,  $\text{♩} = \text{c. } 90$  depending on the acoustic. Facing the audience, senza sord.

\* No fermata when performed in a resonant building. In a drier acoustic, the note may be held much longer, *sempre ff, non dim.*

(a) Allow the sound to reverberate, slowly turn away from the audience, and take harmon mute.

(2) Very slow,  $\text{♩} = \text{c. } 60$ . Facing away, con sord.

(b) Remove mute and slowly turn back to face the audience.

Not as fast as (1),  $\text{♩} = \text{c. } 60$

(a) Allow the sound to reverberate, slowly turn away from the audience, and take harmon mute.

(2) Very slow,  $\text{♩} = \text{c. } 60$ . Facing away, con sord.

(b) Remove mute and slowly turn back to face the audience.

Moderate tempo, neither (1) nor (2). ( $\text{♩} = \text{c. } 45$ )

(a) Allow the sound to reverberate, slowly turn away from the audience, and take harmon mute.

(2) Very slow,  $\text{♩} = \text{c. } 60$ . Facing away, con sord.

Do not turn back. Leave in silence if possible.
