Notes to performers: The voice part may be performed by the solo violist, or by an optional separate narrator/singer. Pitches are suggested and optional. Octave transpositions are acceptable, as is ignoring the notated pitches entirely or even performing the composition as a viola solo with published text. Tempo is generally slow, and flexible enough to accommodate the technical demands of the viola part. The Harmonics in mm. 119-121 produce parallel double octaves with the lower part.
