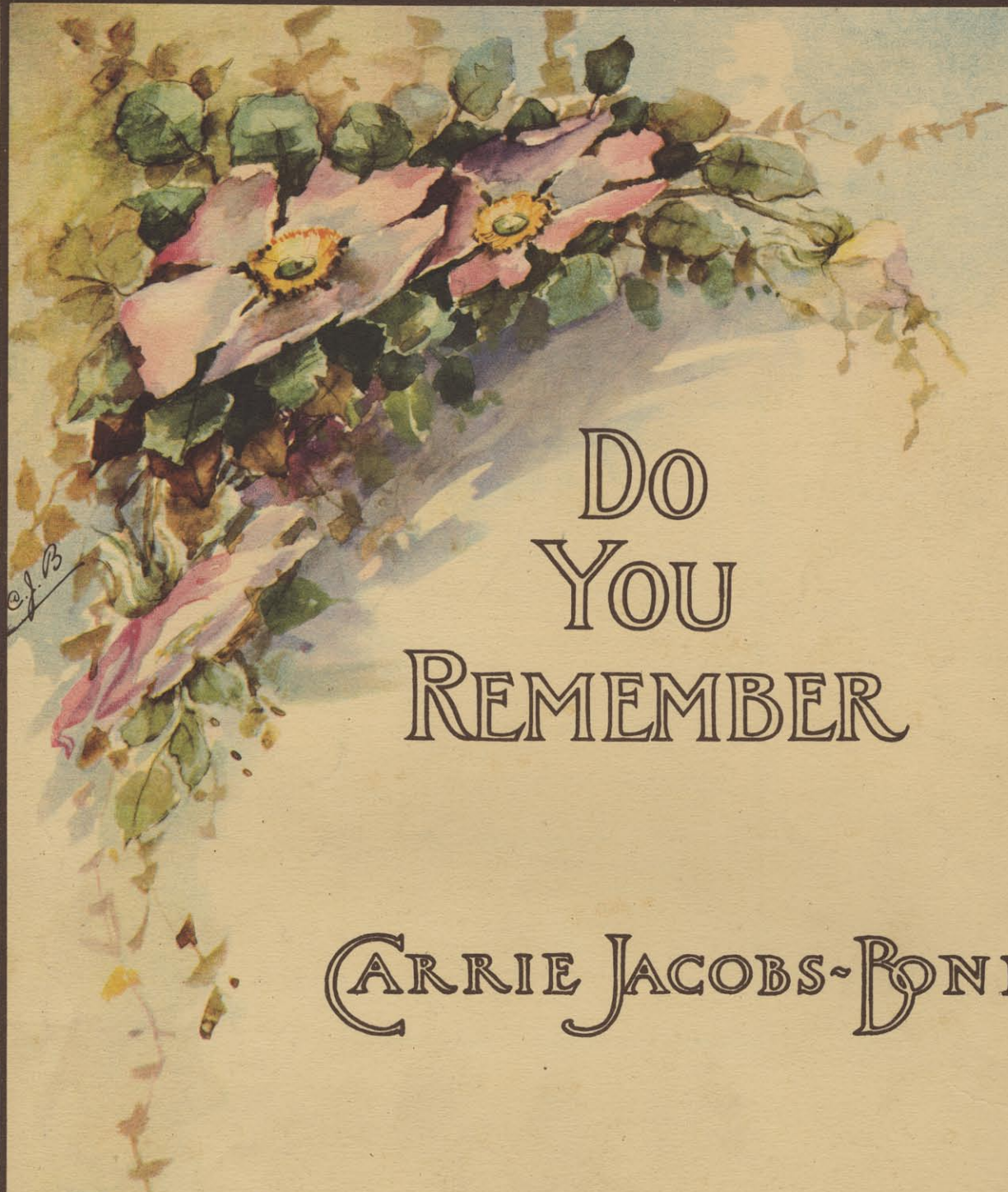




Do YOU REMEMBER
